New recycling containers delivered to 8,000 South Hams homes



Now that we've completed the delivery of new recycling containers to around 8,000 homes in the South Hams on blue and clear sack collections, we're asking resident if they're missing any containers ahead of any changes to the service. Anyone on a blue or clear sack collection who hasn't received their containers can **let us know online here.**

As we are looking to make changes to the service in the near future, we're also aware that some residents may need food waste caddies.

We understand that people may have misplaced their food waste caddies if they've not been using them.

Residents will need these soon as we make improvements to our recycling service. For now, everyone should keep recycling as they are until they hear from us - **but should let us know if they need to order new caddies.**

We'll be sending out a letter to all South Hams residents ahead of any changes to the service.

South Hams District Council has been delivering the containers to the doorsteps and kerbsides of households who currently put out their recycling in blue and clear

sacks. The Council was doing this so that soon, everyone in the district will receive the same kerbside recycling service.

It'll mean we can recycle more than ever before, including food waste.

A letter will be sent to all South Hams residents soon to advise on upcoming changes to the service.

For many residents who already had their containers, the main difference will be that the day of their weekly recycling and waste collections may change.
