SALCOMBE D-DAY 80 COMMITTEE REPORT

This Report is delivered in connection with the meeting of the Salcombe D-Day 80 Committee on 25 April 2024 and relates to Agenda item 4. Ratification.

The Committee made the following decisions outside the meeting, under the Town Clerk's Delegation of Authority, regarding insurance for Salcombe D-Day 80 and in respect of which Agenda item 4. Ratification provides "To ratify certain approvals regarding insurance for Salcombe D-Day 80".

1. Approved that the Committee sources a quote for stand-alone insurance from myBeazley and does not seek three quotes.
2. myBeazley insurance form, event cancellation, approved "No".
3. myBeazley insurance form, public liability, approved "£10 million".
4. Once beacon is on the pontoon will Cllrs John Cooke and Rob Wheeler constantly man it i.e. will never be left alone, approved "Yes, if this is an insurer requirement".
5. Will anyone from Harbour be on the pontoon, I don't think they will be from reading Phil Goodhead's last email, but please confirm, approved "Confirmed".
6. When will the beacon be put on the pontoon and who by i.e. Harbour before they take pontoon to mooring or Cllrs John Cooke and Rob Wheeler, once pontoon moored, approved "Cllrs John Cooke and Rob

Wheeler, once pontoon moored, at any time prior to lighting of the beacon”.

7. How will Cllrs John Cooke and Rob Wheeler get to the pontoon - if Harbour or another 3rd party's boat we need to have a copy of their PLI certificate, approved “By Harbour taxi / launch”.
8. What is the process after the beacon has been finished with i.e. will be hot, where will it be stored etc, approved “The beacon will be turned off and when cool removed from the pontoon, potentially removed before 11pm when the Harbour taxi / launch finishes for the night”.
9. Approved that the Committee will confirm to the Town Clerk once the gas beacon has been checked by someone suitably qualified and / or experienced.
10. Approved that the Committee considers Cllrs John Cooke and Rob Wheeler are competent persons to attend the gas beacon by reference to their knowledge, experience and abilities.
11. Approved that the other points written in green in Gina Pack’s email to the Town Clerk dated 4 April 2024 are duly noted.
