SALCOMBE D-DAY 80 COMMITTEE REPORT

This Report is delivered in connection with the meeting of the Salcombe D-Day 80 Committee on 23 May 2024 and relates to Agenda item 4. Ratification.

The Committee made the following decisions outside the meeting, under the Town Clerk's Delegation of Authority, regarding Salcombe D-Day 80 and in respect of which Agenda item 4. Ratification provides "To ratify certain approvals regarding Salcombe D-Day 80":

- 1) Approved quotes from Simon Roberts (£20.00) and Nick Walker Printing (£69.00 plus VAT) respectively to design and print a banner to advertise Salcombe D-Day 80.
- 2) Approved quality of printed Salcombe D-Day 80 Programme and payment of Nick Walker Printing Ltd invoice for £312.00.
- 3) Approved statements sent to myBeazley insurance company:
 - a) During the hours of operation of the beacon the tide will be no greater than five metres and no less than two metres in depth.
 - b) The beacon will be turned off at approximately 22:30 latest to give the beacon time to cool down before disassembly and removal. This will be weather dependent and may be earlier if there are poor weather conditions. If there is excessive wind Cllrs John Cooke and Rob Wheeler will take a view as to the safety of lighting the beacon and keeping it lit.
 - c) The full procedure for turning off the beacon will be to turn the gas off at the cylinders, wait for a period until everything has cooled down, then disconnect the cylinders and remove the beacon from the pontoon for storage
- 4) Approved for the Flotilla to take place, and that based on the information provided by Salcombe Yacht Club, Salcombe Town Council, as a corporate body, is not involved in the running of this event and therefore does not need to seek additional insurance to cover this event.
